The Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators (“HKI Arb”) will organise the “HKI Arb Training Course on Evaluative Mediation” led by Mr. Ian Hanger AM QC on 10 – 11 November 2018.

The HKI Arb Training Course on Evaluative Mediation (“Course”) is designed to be an intensive course for accredited mediators who have prior knowledge and experience in mediation. The Course will touch on matters relating to evaluative mediation, including issues relating to evaluative mediation in Hong Kong and PRC.

Mr. Ian Hanger AM QC will be the lead overseas trainer of the Course. He is an experienced legal and mediation practitioners in Australia and he will be focusing on matters relating to how to organise and deliver an evaluative mediation in an effective and systematic manner under the perspective of a highly experienced lawyer.

The Course will also cover matters relating to the application of evaluative mediation skills and the legal and regulatory framework of evaluative mediation in Hong Kong which will be presented by experienced and reputable local trainers, including Mrs. Cecilia Wong, Professor Leung Hing Fung and Mr. Winston Siu.

About the Speakers

Overseas Speaker:

Mr. Ian Hanger AM QC was called to the Bar in 1968 and took silk in 1984. He practiced extensively in commercial law and then became a leading practitioner in mediation from 1990. Since that time he has mediated more than 2000 disputes - commercial, construction, estates, trust, negligence, professional negligence, contracts, defamation, insolvency, equity, family provision, and personal injuries arising from abuse.

He is a Mediator for the Court of Arbitration for Sport; a mediator nominated by the Australian Government to the International Centre for the settlement of investment disputes; an arbitrator of the Chinese International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission; a member of the Hong Kong Mediation Panel; a mediator of the Singapore Mediation Centre; an accredited mediator in Australia.

He has conducted workshops on mediation in Australia; Hong Kong and England and given talks on mediation in many overseas jurisdictions. He was a member of the National ADR Advisory Committee to the Attorney General of Australia for many years and has been named in the AFR's list of best lawyers in Australia in the field of ADR for every year from 2008 to present.

He was named Most Highly Regarded for Mediation by Who's Who Legal Australia 2017. He is a life professor at Bond University and was made a member in the Order of Australia in 2007 for services to law in the field of ADR.

Local Speakers:

Mrs. Cecilia Wong is senior solicitor and experienced accredited general mediator, family mediator and family mediation supervisor. Cecilia has conducted hundreds of mediations in various types of dispute, including commercial disputes, personal injuries and negligence cases, construction and building management disputes, family cases, financial disputes and intellectual property disputes, etc. Recently, Cecilia was appointed as a mediator of the Qianhai Court, Shenzhen, PRC.



Professor Leung Hing Fung, is a practising mediator, arbitrator and barrister. He is an Associate Professor in the Department of Real Estate and Construction, University of Hong Kong specialising in alternative dispute resolution, land law and construction law. Since 2003, Professor Leung has been practising as a mediator and his experience in mediation covers disputes in various fields, including huge commercial and land disputes involving billions of Hong Kong dollars. He is a member of the Panels of General Accredited Mediators of HKMAAL, HKIAC and HKIS / HKIA. He is also an Invited Mediator in the International Court of Mediation of the Shanghai Free Trade Zone.

Mr. Winston Siu is a commercial mediator accredited by CEDR (London), general mediator accredited by Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre, Hong Kong Mediation Centre, and CEDR trained mediator assessor. He is a Coach U graduate. He has a passion for working in and teaching mediation, and coaching people to excel. His particular strength is in negotiation as he has always been a deal-maker in his past working experience and in everyday life. He likes to think out-of-the-box and to create win-win solutions. Mr. Siu is a mediation practitioner, trainer, coach and assessor for various mediation programmes.
